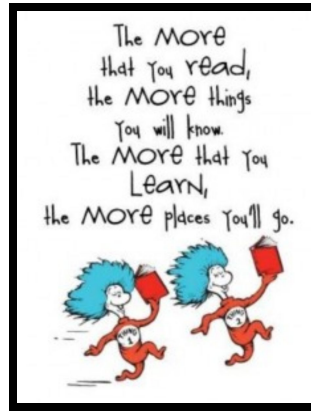

I will use the **Remind App** for parent/teacher communications, classroom updates, and student progress. You will need to download the Remind app.

Classroom Expectations

1. Follow directions the first time given.
2. Be on time and prepared **daily** for class with a **charged Chromebook and a pencil**.
3. Participate in class discussions and activities.
4. **No food or drinks are allowed in class** (drinks with closable lids will be permitted).
5. Be respectful to yourself and others (keep hands, feet, objects, and negative comments to yourself).
6. Here is my Math disclosure!
7. **No Cell phones visible** during instruction time (**keep them in your backpack**). Students will get one warning. All class work will be assigned, turned in, and graded digitally through Canvas whenever possible. Students are expected to redo assignments as needed to earn their desired grades.

1. We will use digital tools such as Aleks.com, Bigideasmath.com, and other annotated programs. If students are required to complete an assignment on paper, it may be turned in to the turn-in box, and/or they may take a clear picture of their written work and submit it on Canvas.
2. All students **must** complete all assigned work by the given due date.
3. Students can redo assignments and assessments following specific criteria.
4. An Aleks Pie Chart will also be a part of our weekly assignments (more info to come on this.)

Attendance

Students who are absent for a short or long period of time should use Canvas and the online tools provided to keep up with classwork. Please email me if your student needs additional accommodations due to extraneous circumstances.

Citizenship

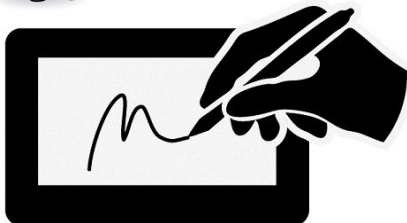
