Study skills is designed for students who need additional time to complete work from other classes. Course Objective:

- ★ Students will learn various social, organizational, communication, character ed traits, and study skills.
- ★ Students will take an active part in getting their assignments completed and turned in to their teachers.

My Expectations of You:

- Be on time!!
- Follow instructions the first time they are given.
- Come prepared to work. This means bringing work from other classes to work on, having papers, pencil, chromebooks, and other materials needed in order to complete the assignment. Also, bringing a book to silently read if assignments get caught up.
- Respect yourself and others (we are in a learning environment, limit distractions by listening and appreciating others without judgment of where they are and keeping body and objects to yourself)
- Follow School Policies. This includes NO personal cell phones, earbuds, or other electronic devices. These are a MAJOR distraction to the learning environment. In Roberts class, she will ask that your phones be set to airplane mode to avoid distractions. If she sees your phone out, there will be a verbal warning as a courtesy and additional reminders will include confiscating the phone until the end of class or taken to the office and a contact home with it logged in the system the number of times the infraction has occurred.
