Materials

Students are expected to come to class with a pencil and their charged chromebook that has been assigned to them. Other materials such as calculators, paper, textbooks, etc. will be supplied by the teacher with the understanding that they take care of the items being borrowed and respect Ms. Roberts property.

How to succeed

All students have the ability to succeed in Math. It just requires a commitment to paying attention, effort on every assignment, asking questions, turning in work on time and re-do any work or test that had a low score. Most important of all: Never give up!

If you find yourself struggling with an assignment or test, make arrangements to meet with your teacher during advisory time or other time.

Assignments

Class discussions, assignments and assessments are how students communicate with the teacher their understanding of the concepts. This feedback from the students allows the teacher to plan if reteaching is needed or the class is ready to move to the next section. For teachers to make this decision, work must be turned in on time. Work that is turned in on time may be redone for full credit.

Late Work

Work that is turned in after the due date will receive a drop of 20%. If the assignment is more than two weeks late it will only receive up to 50%. Work assigned before midterms will not be accepted after the midterm cut off date set by the teacher.

Grades

Grades will be given according to the following grading scale:

A = 93-100%

B = 83-86%

C = 73-76%

D = 60-64%

Citizenship

Citizenship grades reflect the students adherence to the rules, the effort put forth in the class, and the attitude of the student. According to school policy 1-2 rule infractions will earn the student an S (satisfactory) citizenship grade. 3-4 infractions will result in an N (needs improvement) and more than 4 infractions is a U (unacceptable). Cheating, truancies and safe school violations* will result in an automatic N or U as determined by the instructor.

*Please note that Safe School Policy infractions will be immediately referred to the administration.

The most important rule for school is to show **RESPECT** to the teacher, other students. and yourself. The school rules are listed in the student folder received at registration, but here are a few to keep in mind:

- Be on time and in your seat with your materials, ready to work. See school tardy policy. (Prepare to Learn)
- Keep your hands, feet, and objects to yourself. If it's not yours don't touch it. (Be Kind)
- Follow instructions the first time they are given and don't talk back or try to argue with the teacher. (Be respectful)
- Do your own work and turn it in on time. (Try your best)
- Make-up, toys, or any other objects that distract from schoolwork are not allowed in class.
- No horseplay, hitting, throwing items, or other physical contact. (safe school infractions)

Cell phones, earbuds and headphones are not allowed to be used in the classroom unless permission is given by the teacher. While in math class students will be expected to have their phones on airplane mode and put away to avoid unnecessary distractions. If you need to get a hold of your child at any time in the school day other than their lunch time, PLEASE contact the office. Cell phones are a HUGE distraction for a student and the excuse of "my mom is texting me" is not reason enough to be distracting to self or others during class time. Cell phones will be confiscated if they are out without permission. If Ms. Roberts sees a phone or earbuds, she will ask the student to put it away as a courtesy warning and after that it will move to offenses. 1st offense (get back at end of class, contact parent, and noted), 2nd offense (taken to office to be picked up at a later time, contact parent, and noted), and any offense after 2nd offense, phone will go to the office and parents may need to come into the school to pick it up.
