6. Panorama Survey
  - a. Window open from November 15th - November 30th

- b. Our school uses Panorama to support student learning. The tool helps teachers and administrators visualize and interpret data to directly improve student outcomes. We use the platform to monitor academic and behavioral progress with students as well as to raise awareness of the emotional and mental health needs.
  - c. Panorama's survey tools help us measure and support soft skills: growth mindset, self-efficacy, social awareness, and self-management.
  - d. The survey provides feedback from students on their experiences in school. This information helps us create support systems for students so they feel safe, included and empowered to achieve.
  - e. Each survey is reasonably short and is completely confidential and anonymous.
