- SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT GOALS:

We are working on getting our Ridge Reward Program up and running again. This allows kids to be rewarded for good behavior with a ticket to put in a box. Every Monday we will draw 5 names for a prize. Students have started to travel during sting time. Things are off to a great start.

- TRUSTLAND EXPENDITURES:

- Sherry Patton proposed that we have another Math Lab this year, Student Advocate; she will start on Sept.27, 2021. Still employ our LCSW Tami Denton. She will be helping our Tier 3 students.

- TSSA:

- We have recurring money to put towards our MTSS Support Systems, Ridge Rewards and Co-Teaching. We will be starting a new Program called PM School. This will be a place for Students to go to get help with homework or those that are failing or have failed a class. This will be from 3:00-4:30 every Tuesday and Thursday. This money will cover the cost of Technology, ALEX Licenses. The amount of Licensed has gone up as our enrollment has increased.

- ESSER: This is a one time amount of money coming from the Government. All monies spent have to be COVID related. 72,000 of this money will be for Teachers who have agreed to a buyout for certain classes.

- COVID UPDATE:

- We are taking precautions every day. We are practicing one way traffic. We have a 5.75hr contact tracer that is housed at Sand Ridge. She has been handling all of these calls. They are discussing a possible Test to Stay if things get worse.

- We have a Weber Innovations Center Accelerated Program for the first time this year. We currently have 13 9th grade students participating in this class.

- PM School
- We have a new Administrator helping us for until the 2nd half of the School year. His name is Jeff Jackson. We welcome him and are happy to have him help us out.
- Advisory Update: Kids are traveling this year. We are excited to have this up and running again. Kids will go to their Advisory period, then wait 5 minutes and transition if a teacher has requested them or a student needs help in a certain subject.
- Extracurricular Games are up and going. To start off we have Softball and Football going on now. The Jr. High's Football fields have been a little worn out this year with the dry weather.
